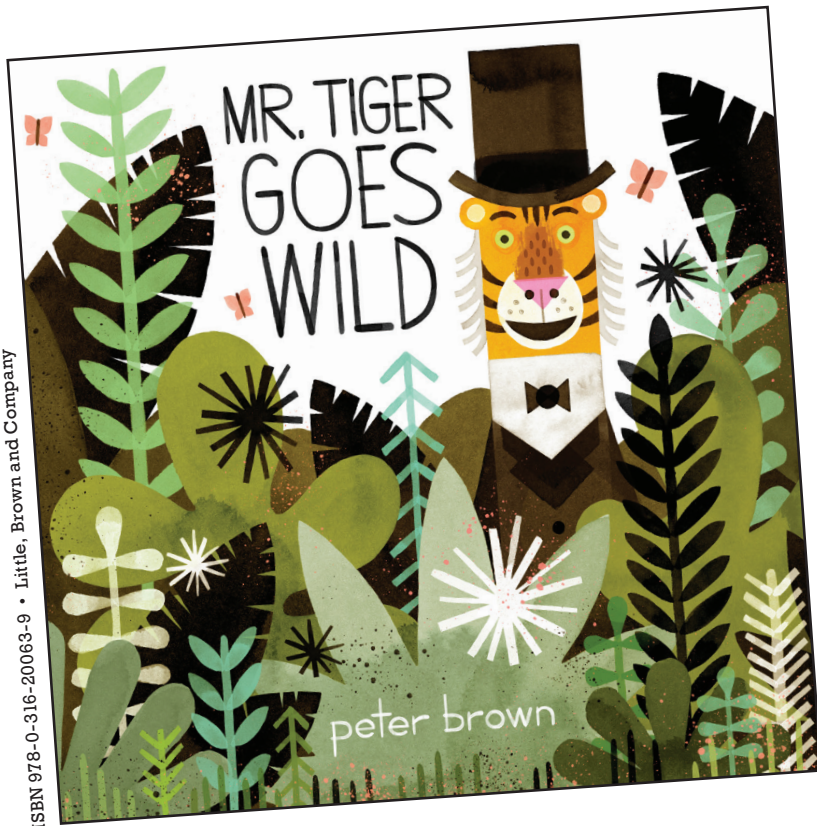

# Mr. Tiger Stick Puppets

## Mr. Tiger Matching Game

2-3 players

**INSTRUCTIONS:** Shuffle the cards. Place the cards face-down on a table or the floor, arranging them in any way you want. Go wild! Players take turns turning over two cards.

If the images on the cards don't match, the player replaces the cards, face-down, where they came from, and the next player takes his/her turn. When the images match, the player keeps the pair of cards, and gets to choose two more cards. The player with the most cards at the end of the game wins!
